

Privacy Notice

Effective: February 10, 2023

This is the privacy notice (“Privacy Notice”) of Stonemaier LLC (“Stonemaier,” “we,” “us,” or “our”).

We at Stonemaier recognize the importance of protecting your personal information. To demonstrate our commitment maintaining the privacy of your personal information, we have created this Privacy Notice to inform you of our privacy practices for the personal information that we collect and receive through use of our products and services either offlin person or online (collectively, the “Services”). Our online operations include all websites and applications (collectively, “Sites”) of Stonemaier.

What Personal Information Stonemaier Collects

What personal information we collect depends on what Services you choose to use and how you interact with us.

- **Contact information** such as name, email address, mailing address, and phone number, while completing an or contact form, as part of a registration, survey, competition or an information request. The data are deleted as so they are no longer needed to achieve the purpose for which they were collected.
- **Account information** such as any username that you may select in connection with establishing an account on Sites.
- **Financial and payment information** such as information we need to complete a rental including a credit or de card number.
- **Internet Activity** such as your Internet Protocol (“IP”) address, browsing history, your search history and information on your interaction with the Sites.
- **Commercial Information** including products or services you have purchased, returned, exchanged, or consider your preferences.
- **Job Applicant Information** including professional or employment-related information (such as education and employment history) and any other information you provide in connection with applying and interviewing for employment at Stonemaier. If we retain you as an employee, this may include, among other things, your Social Security number or taxpayer ID.
- **Other personal information** collected online or offline to help us better identify and offer Services and information that we believe may be of interest to you, or help us better understand your experience with our Services.
- **Communications with us** including interactions with us and contacts through social media channels, photogra images, videos, comments, product reviews, testimonials, and other content).
- **Inferences** drawn from any of the personal information described above to create a profile about your preferenc behavior, characteristics, and attitudes.
- **Geolocation:** location in real time when you have activated this service to offer our products and services depending on where you are located.

How Stonemaier Collects Personal Information

We may collect personal information from various sources, including:

- **Personal information that you provide.** We may collect personal information that you provide to us when you create an account or use our Services. Such information may include, but not be limited to, contact information (such as your name, phone number, and email address).
- **Personal information collected when you interact with our Sites.** When you visit our websites, open or click emails we send you, or interact with our advertisements, we automatically collect certain information using online tracking technologies such as pixels, and cookies. For more information about this, please see our [cookies section](#) below.

If you choose to submit any Personal Information relating to other people, you represent that you have the authority to do so and permit us to use the information in accordance with this Policy.

You may choose not to provide some of your personal information to us, but this may prevent us from providing our Services to you, or limit our ability to provide you with the level of service that you would otherwise expect from us. For example, if you obscure your IP address and you click on a product on our website, you may not be directed to the correct regional webstore.

From time to time, we may use or augment the personal information we have about you with information obtained from other sources, such as public databases, social media platforms and other third parties.

How Stonemaier Uses Personal Information

To provide the level of service we believe you expect from us, we may use your personal information to:

- **Provide and develop our Services.** We collect information to provide our Services, offer support, maintain our Sites, and better understand the interests of our customers. We may also use your information to customize your experience with Stonemaier such as recognizing you when you visit our websites, remembering your preferences, showing you more relevant advertisements.
- **Process transactions.** We collect payment information to process your transactions and deliver our Services.
- **Communicate with you.** We use your information to respond to your inquiries from you. We may send you administrative communications regarding our Services and any rentals you may have reserved. We may also notify you about special promotions or offers that may be of interest to you and invite you to participate in surveys about our products or services.
- **Email Marketing.** We may periodically send you relevant alerts and newsletters by e-mail. To help improve our marketing activities, we often receive a confirmation when you open an e-mail or click on a link included in one of these emails, if your computer supports such capabilities. Instructions on how to unsubscribe from these alerts and newsletters are included in each e-mail.

- **Analytics and Personalization.** We use personal information to conduct research and analytics, including to improve our services and product offerings; to understand how you interact with our websites, advertisements, and communications with you; to determine which of our products or services are the most popular; to improve our websites, and marketing campaigns; to personalize your experience; to save you time when you visit our website to customize the marketing and advertising that we show you; to create a more personalized experience for you when you visit our stores; to provide services; to better understand our customers' needs; and to provide personalized recommendations about our products and services.
- **Security and Fraud Prevention.** We may use personal information to monitor, detect and prevent fraud and improper or illegal activity and protect you, Stonemaier, our other customers, and the public. We also use data to secure our online services including our network, websites and apps debug our online services.
- **Comply with Law.** To comply with applicable law, comply with Stonemaier's legal and regulatory obligations, and defend ourselves in litigation and investigations and to prosecute litigation.
- **Applicant.** We use Job Applicant Information to make decisions about recruitment and in anticipation of a contract of employment. Providing this information is required for employment.

We may use personal information collected from any of the sources listed in "How Stonemaier collects personal information" section of this policy for our internal business purposes, such as data analysis, audits, developing new products, enhancing our Services, identifying usage trends and determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns. We may also use inferences drawn from personal information to create a profile reflecting your preferences

How Stonemaier Discloses Your Personal Information

Stonemaier may disclose your personal information within the Stonemaier family of companies. We may also disclose your information to our service providers, who act on our behalf, our partners and collaborators, and with other entities at your direction. Stonemaier does not sell personal information or disclose personal information to third parties to use for their own benefit.

Below are more details on the parties to whom Stonemaier discloses data.

- **Service Providers.** We disclose certain personal information to service providers that perform services to support our core business functions and internal operations including: fulfilling orders; delivering packages; complying with your request for the shipment of products to; sending e-mails; analyzing customer data; processing credit card and debit card payments; investigating fraudulent activity;
- **Collaborators.** Collaborators are partners or other organizations, such as fulfillment centers, with which we jointly develop and/or promote our Services.
- **Public Forums.** Some of our websites provide the opportunity to post content in a public forum. If you decide to submit information in these public forums, that information will be publicly available.
- **In connection with a merger, acquisition, or business transfer.** We may disclose personal information with another company that buys some, or all, of the assets or stock of Stonemaier, and that company may use and disclose personal information for purposes similar to what is described in this policy. Stonemaier may also disclose personal information with prospective purchasers to evaluate the proposed transaction.
- **Government, regulatory, and law enforcement agencies.** Stonemaier reserves the right to disclose your information to respond to authorized information requests from government authorities, to respond to valid judicial requests, to address national security situations, to provide security and investigate potential fraud, or when otherwise required by applicable law. Stonemaier may also disclose your personal information as required by law to any competent law enforcement body, regulatory or government agency, court or other third party where we believe the disclosure is necessary or appropriate to comply with a regulatory requirement, judicial proceeding, court or

government request or legal process served on us, or to protect the safety, rights, or property of our customers, the public, Stonemaier or others, and to exercise, establish or defend Stonemaier's legal rights.

How We Protect Your Personal Information

Personal information is maintained on our servers or those of our service providers, and is accessible by authorized employees, representatives, and agents as necessary for the purposes described in this privacy policy.

We realize that individuals trust us to protect their personal information. We maintain reasonable and appropriate physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards designed to help protect your personal information. While we attempt to protect personal information in our possession, no method of transmission over the internet or security system is perfect, and we cannot promise that information about you will remain secure in all circumstances.

For your convenience, our websites include functionality that allows you to remain logged in so that you do not have to enter your password each time you want to access your account. If you choose to remain logged in, you should be aware that anyone with access to your device will be able to access and make changes to your account and may be able to make purchases through your account. For that reason, if you choose to remain logged in, we strongly recommend that you take appropriate steps (such as enabling the "Passcode Lock" security feature on your mobile device) to protect against unauthorized access to, and use, of your account. Please also notify us as soon as possible if you suspect any unauthorized use of your account or password.

Your Rights

Consistent with applicable law, you may exercise the rights described in this section. Please note that some of the rights may vary depending on your country, province, or state of residence.

The Right to Opt Out of Cookies and Sale/Sharing Using Online Tracking Technologies

Our use of online tracking technologies may be considered a "sale" / "sharing" under applicable law. Visitors to our US website can opt out of being tracked by these third parties by clicking the "Cookies Settings" link at the bottom of our website.

If you do not have a webstore Stonemaier account or if you are not logged into your Stonemaier account, your request to opt out of "sale" / "sharing" will be linked to your browser identifier only and not linked to any account information because the connection between your browser and the account is not known to us.

California and Colorado residents may opt out by broadcasting an Opt-Out Preference Signal, such as the Global Privacy Control (GPC) (on the browsers and/or browser extensions that support such a signal). Categories of personal information disclosed that may be considered “sale” / “sharing”: Basic Identifying Information, Device Information and Other Unique Identifiers, Internet or Other Network Activity, and Commercial Data.

Categories of third parties to whom personal information was disclosed that may be considered “sale” / “sharing” include advertisers and marketing partners, data analytics providers, and social media networks.

The Right to Accessing, Correcting, and Deleting Personal Information

You may have the right to request access to and receive details about the personal information we maintain about you and how we have processed it, correct inaccuracies, get a copy of, or delete your personal information. You may also have the right to withdraw your consent to our processing of your personal information. If you are a resident of California, Colorado, Connecticut, or Virginia you have the rights to access, correct, and delete personal information under the applicable law (when these laws become effective). If you are a resident of Canada, you have the right to access your personal information and withdraw your consent from processing. These rights may be limited in some circumstances by applicable law.

Access and Deletion

Typically, we retain your personal information for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this privacy policy, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law. Please note that in many situations we must retain all, or a portion, of your personal information to comply with our legal obligations; resolve disputes; enforce our agreements; protect against fraudulent, deceptive, or illegal activity; or for another one of our business purposes.

Corrections

You may submit a request for a copy of the information collected about you by following the steps outlined in the “Your Rights” section above. Responding to Requests

Once you have submitted your request, we will respond within the time frame permitted by the applicable law. Please note that we may charge a reasonable fee for multiple requests in the same 12-month period, as permitted by law.

Appealing Requests

If you are a Colorado, Connecticut, or Virginia resident, you may appeal our decision to your request regarding your personal information. To do so, please contact us in any of the ways listed in the “[Contact Us](#)” section, including privacy@stonemaier.com. We respond to all appeal requests as soon as we reasonably can, and no later than legally required.

Identity Verification

For us to process some requests, we will need to verify your identity to confirm that the request came from you. We may contact you by phone or e-mail to verify your request. Depending on your request, we will ask for information such as your name, an e-mail address that you have used with us. For certain requests, we may also ask you to provide details about your most recent purchase you made online or in store.

Managing Communication Preferences

Email

You can stop receiving promotional e-mails at any time by clicking on the “unsubscribe” link at the bottom of any promotional e-mail that you receive from us.

Removing Content from our Public Forums

You can request that we remove content or information that you have posted on a public page on some of our websites by e-mailing details to Customer Service at privacy@stonemaier.com. Please note that while we will endeavor to honor your request, our removal of your content or information does not ensure complete or comprehensive removal of that information from our website. For example, historical copies, or “caches,” may remain.

Retention

Stonemaier will retain PI for the length of time needed to fulfil the purposes outlined in this privacy policy and for accounting and record-keeping purposes unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law or when needed to manage disputes and legal claims. Data may also be kept for studies and statistics after having been processed so as to prevent it being reassigned to other identified persons. Stonemaier may also need to retain documents that contain PI for a longer period to comply with preservation obligations in litigations and government investigations.

Website Tracking and the Use of Cookies and Other Technologies

If you use our Sites, certain information may be collected from your computer in the course of your use of our Sites. As with many websites, we may use both session based and persistent “cookies” and/or other technology (e.g., web bugs, e-mail bugs, clear GIFs, web beacons, tracker GIFs and “clickstream” data logs) in our Sites or in our electronic communication with you to enhance the functionality of our Sites and Services. These technologies also make your transactions and other activities more convenient and efficient.

Cookies

“Cookies” are small amounts of data that a website can send to your web browser and store on your computer. It is our policy not to save sensitive data, such as passwords or credit card information in cookies.

Most web browsers are initially set up to accept cookies. You have the option of disabling or refusing cookies at any time through your browser preferences. However, note that some parts of our Sites will not function properly or may be considerably slower if you refuse cookies. For example, without cookies, you will not be able to set personalized preferences, and/or you may have difficulty completing transactions. How are you Informed?

When you visit our Site for the first time and Stonemaier plans to place Cookies other than “technical”, we inform you that we use Cookies using a cookie management module including information notices and settings appearing on the home page of the Site. By clicking on “Accept all”, you consent to our use of Cookies as described in our Cookies management module. That being said, you can modify the settings relating to cookies at any time by clicking on the link to the Cookies management module on our home page (“[Cookie Preferences](#)”).

Your Choices Regarding Cookies

By using our site, you can consent to the use of the aforementioned Cookies. Your choices are kept for six (6) months. However, you can choose at any time to deactivate all or part of these Cookies.

Transfers of Personal Data Outside the European Union

Please note that some of our partners offering digital advertising services being located outside the European Union, the data collected using cookies may be transferred to countries that are not members of the European Union, whose legislation on the protection of personal data differs from that applicable in UK. We strictly require our partners to use the information collected using Cookies on our Site only to manage or provide the services requested and ask them to always act in accordance with applicable data protection laws, personal information and to pay particular attention to the confidentiality of the information transmitted.

For Deeper Understanding the Use of Cookies

“Technical” Cookies

Technical Cookies include cookies strictly necessary for browsing the Site (such as session identifiers), as well as Functionality Cookies which allow you to access specific functions, in particular to recognize you, to report your visit to such or such page and thus improve your browsing comfort, in particular by:

- storing information relating to a form that you have completed on our Site (registration or access to your account or to products, services or information that you have chosen on our Site (subscribed service, content of an order basket, etc. .)),
- allowing you to access reserved and personal areas of our Site such as your account, using identifiers or data that you may have previously entrusted to us,
- implementing security measures, for example when you are asked to log in again to content or a service after a certain period of time,
- adapting the presentation of the site to the display preferences of your Terminal (language used, display resolution).

Technical Cookies also include cookies necessary for real-time monitoring of any malfunctions occurring on the Site. These cookies make it possible to minimize the duration of identification of failures in order to implement corrective actions as soon as possible to ensure the best continuity of service of the Site.

You can object to the use of this type of cookie and delete it by using your browser settings, however you may no longer be able to access to the Site and/or services of the Site.

Payment Security Cookies

Cookies can be used to fight against fraud on the Internet (prevention of payment fraud, identity theft, etc.) In this respect Stonemaier or its service providers acting on its behalf may deposit, subject to your rights, tracers in order to collect information relating to the Terminal that made it possible to carry out the order (in particular the operating system used, the use or not of a proxy, etc.). These “fingerprint” type tracers associated with your order data are used to validate your order. This information may be transmitted to any third party authorized by law or to fraud prevention and detection service providers designated by Stonemaier for the sole purpose of verifying the identity of the buyer, the validity of the order,

However, in the event of refusal to note the use of cookies for the purposes of securing transactions, your order cannot be validated automatically and must be the subject of a manual review. You may be asked for proof of identity in order to validate your order.

Audience Measurement Cookies

Audience measurement cookies make it possible to measure the audience of the various contents and sections of our Site in order to evaluate them and better organize them, and in particular to:

- establish statistics and volumes of visits and use of the various elements making up our Site (section and content visited, routes) allowing us, if necessary, to detect navigation problems and consequently to improve interest and ergonomics of our services
- adapt the presentation of our Site or our advertising spaces to the display preferences of your terminal (language used, display resolution, operating system used, etc.) during your visits to our Site, depending on the equipment used or reading software that your terminal includes.
- measure the effectiveness of our emailing campaigns, allowing us to initiate relevant commercial actions based on the information thus collected (for example the sending of a new message or a personalized offer).

Audience measurement cookies are issued by us or by our service providers.

The traffic analysis services used by this Site only produce and send our technical service providers aggregated statistics and traffic volumes. These statistics are reconciled with the statistics of visits to other sites, as well as with your customer data.

The Site may use a tool called “Google Analytics” to collect information about the use of the Site. Google Analytics collects information such as how often users visit this site, what pages they visit when they do so, and what other sites they use prior to coming to this Site. We use the information we get from Google Analytics to maintain and improve the Site and our products. We do not combine the information collected through the use of Google Analytics with personally identifiable information. Google’s ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to this Site is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Service, available at <http://www.google.com/analytics/terms/us.html>, and the Google Privacy Policy, available at <http://www.google.com/policies/privacy/>. Advertising Cookies

Purpose

The use of advertising cookies makes it possible to determine the advertising content for the promotion of the products and/or services offered on our website exclusively and likely to correspond to the centers of interest deduced from the previous navigation of the terminal concerned, in particular in:

- counting the total number of advertisements displayed by us on our advertising spaces, to identify these advertisements, their respective number of displays, the number of users who clicked on each advertisement and, where applicable, the subsequent actions carried out by these users on the pages to which these advertisements lead,
- adapting the advertising content of our Site and on terminal by our advertising spaces as well as our offers, according to the navigation of your terminal on our Site and the purchases that you can make
- insofar as you have provided us with personal data, in particular your electronic contact details, during your registration, your order, to associate this data with navigation information in order to address you, for example, electronic prospecting or to display on your terminal, within advertising spaces that we issue, personalized advertisements which are specifically intended for you and likely to be of personal interest to you;
- send you electronic prospecting based on your user profile.

How is information collected by Advertising Cookies?

Advertising Cookies are placed on the user's terminal using tracking technologies ("Tracker") provided by our partners which are inserted into the pages visited on the Site.

This Tracer will automatically transmit information on the content of the page visited. This information is associated with the identifier contained in the Cookies placed on your Terminal.

How is this information associated?

When you have an online account, or when you place an order, the information collected using advertising Cookies on the Site is reconciled and combined with that from the use of your account or our products and services and thus make it possible to draw up your user profile which is used for the purposes of advertising targeting and commercial prospecting.

What is the point of seeing advertisements adapted to your navigation?

Your interest in the advertising content that is displayed on your Terminal when you consult a Site often determines the advertising resources of the latter allowing it to operate its services, often provided to users free of charge. This allows us and third parties to display advertisements that are relevant to what interests you rather than advertisements that are of no interest to you.

Visiting Third-Party Websites

Our Sites may contain links or references to third party websites. These websites are outside of our control, and the privacy policies of these sites may differ from our own. Please be aware that we have no control over these third-party websites and our Privacy Notice does not apply to such websites. We encourage you to check the terms of use and privacy policies of websites before disclosing any personal information via such websites.

Occasionally when linking to a third-party website from our Sites, you may still see Stonemaier affiliate logo or a Stonemaier affiliate website frame. This is to provide you with a seamless experience when visiting our Sites. In these cases you are no longer on our Sites but the third-party website, and therefore the information collection practices of the third party's website may differ from Stonemaier's. The privacy notice of the third party website will govern how information collected from you is used by the owner of the website. You can always know what website you are on by checking the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) in the location bar within your browser.

Linking your Stonemaier Accounts to Your Social Profiles

Social Sharing

In an effort to provide our customers with new ways of sharing content, we may enable some of our online content to be shared on social websites through hosted sharing links and icons. Users who share content and links through their social media profiles should be aware that all activities of this nature are public.

Please note, when you share (with or without adding your own comments) any of our content on your social media profile that action is governed by the privacy notice of that social media platform, and not Stonemaier's Privacy Notice. We do not track or store a record of those comments or actions.

If you choose to participate in posting or sharing activities, you are electing to share and display such public activities on our Sites. Due to the public nature of your posting or sharing your posts may be included in RSS feeds, APIs and made available to other websites via other formats.
